RE BELLEVUE RANCH.


Your letter of the 5th re Bellevue has just come in, with enclosed transcript of accounts.

I had expected to hear from you whether you were coming East this month, or not, and wrote you on November 10th asking about this, but have had no acknowledgment. If you are coming, it would be much better to go over these statements with you, and I would ask you to kindly write me by return mail whether you will be here or not, and if so, on what date.

I gather from the statement that the taxes have been increased in the year from \$168.76 to \$255.96, an increase of 52%. Was any reason given for this increase, or any appeal registered against the taxation? Also, please let me know what the discount is if paid by December 30th.

As soon as I hear from you I will write you fully, providing you are not going to be here, and in the meantime will go over such records as I have of Bellevue since the beginning of its fiscal year.
