Dear Sir:-

With reference to our telegram of the 5th inst, on that date Mr G.A. Hewer received a telegram from Mr Goldie offering to pay him \$9,250, on the 6th inst. in settlement for shares in the Rainbow Ranche, the documents for which were in escrow with the Royal Bank of Canada, but the balance of money due to Hewer was assigned by him to the Bank of Montreal, and the assignment is held by your Office under Safe Keeping #232.

Mr Goldie's telegram read \$9,250. cash settlement and Mr Hewer wanted to make sure that \$1,000. assigned to McAllister was to be provided for by Mr Goldie and not deducted from the \$9,250. the total amount due on the escrow being \$10,500. Mr Hewer was willing to accept settlement in cash giving discount of \$250. and accrued interest, but was not willing to settle unless the \$1,000. was paid by Mr Goldie, as a discount of \$1,250. and accrued interest would be too much to give.
