Dear Jim:-

I have had considerable trouble in keeping track of your movements as I have written four letters to you one to Eysholt & 3 to Kenora but from your last letter I surmise you have received them, I am still on the C.P.R. at Kenora having moved up from 'Jackie' about 2 months ago. I am at present helping the Resd. Engineer here on the yard & new Round House. Work will be closing down here at the end of this month, and just at present my plans are not definite as I have a few things in view. A young contractor on the C.P.R. wants one to go in with him on some trestle bridges and if we can make satisfactory arrangements will take it up but I hardly think we will get our price. There are all kinds of openings here and I wish you were down here as I am sure we could pick something up together but it requires someone to be rustling around all the time. And this is what I want to find out.

Do you know of anything out there in the way of building bridges culverts etc. for if there are any chances let me know at once and I will make arrangements to go out. If there is not I think I will go home for a week or two and
