There is nothing new in the situation. The wheat market with a few ups and downs continues very strong but the flour trade has slacked off considerable, which of course we looked for at this time of the year. We are still considerably above the export basis.

I have a reply from G.V. Hastings regarding the railway through Penticton. He saw Mr. White, who was unable to say whether anything would be done or not but he is bringing the matter before the President when he goes to Montreal with estimates, which will be shortly after the new year and G.V. suggests me going to Montreal to see Mr. White. Notwithstanding the above, G.V. says his ideas are that something will be done in that district.
