I am in receipt of yours of the 17th but I am sorry that you did not give me more information regarding the transportation from Midway to Penticton. The information you give I already have had several days from the C.P.R. but there has been some doubt cast upon the stage trip from Keremeos to Penticton. The people in Toronto do not advise any of their passengers to take this trip. From the time of the Jim Hill Road, it seems that it takes two days to get from Midway to Keremeos, one train starting from Midway at 4.50 and arriving at Oroville at 7.35 p.m/, at which place the passenger has to stop overnight leaving next morning at 8, arriving at Keremeos at 10.30. The question is, does the stage leave Keremeos before 10.30 or after. I think the best plan would be for you to come over to Eholt and see them as you intend to go and see Scott anyway, they could then return to the main line via Nelson and Revelstoke. They purpose leaving here on the first of July. Henry has some symptoms of pleurisy as a result of a fall in which he broke a rib. According to the time card laid out for them, they should arrive at Eholt on the 10th of July but if there is any change made in this plan, I will let you know in plenty of time. I will endeavor to have their tickets made out so that it would be possible for them to go either via Nelson and Revelstoke or Penticton & Sycamous.

Business is absolutely dead. Nothing doing whatever.
