To J.N. McAllister:- "Hewer has not received agreement. Has it

To Maddock Brothers:- "Agreement not completed account lack  
"information, will forward incomplete draft."  
Sgd. J.N. McAllister.

On March 25th, I wrote to L. Morris, the Vernon Government Agent, asking  
him for copies of your water records, whether the irrigation matter was in  
the name of Maddock Brothers or a separate company and if the latter its name  
and date of incorporation, also whether its rights included the privilege of  
supplying water for irrigation purposes permanently to the Rainbow Rancho.

I would ask you to kindly ask Mr. Morris to let me have the information  
requested at once as matters cannot be concluded until your privileges in  
regard to supplying water are approved by our solicitor, and we do not know  
with whom the agreement is to be drawn. In order to save time however we will  
finish up a draft of an agreement and forward to Mr. Hewer for joint approval  
meantime trusting to receive the necessary information to prepare the document  
in proper form, the agreement can then be rewritten as soon as we receive your  
approval of the draft.
