stances this 8% may not equal the amount previously advanced. There could be three reasons for this; the shipper concerned may have

1. More than the average bulk or "distress" shipments.
2. Over-estimated on stocks.
3. Less than average pack-out of desirable grades and sizes.

With reference to "distress" shipments, there of course is no previous basis for advancing on this class of fruit and until such time as the Industry Pool Committee determines the standing of these "distress" apples we are using the figure of \$20.00 a ton or 40¢ a box for advance purposes.
