Sir,

Stallions of one year old or upwards at any time of the year, to the West of the Cascades, and stallions of two years old and upwards from the 1st of August to the first of May to the East of the Cascades. The foregoing is unlawful. That is to say that West of the Cascade, over a year old, can run at large, and that East of the Cascades, 2 years old and upwards can run at large from ^{1st} August to 1st of May.

We are East of the Cascades, and stallions under 2 years old can be at large all the time and over 2 years old may be at large only during ^{May} June and July.
