Your letter to hand in reference to the envelopes which we forwarded recently, and do not quite know what you mean to convey in your very brief remarks. We will grant that the envelope which we last supplied is not quite the same as the sample which you sent; but we will say that it is fully as good so far as quality is concerned, and probably a shade better, and the only real difference is that your original envelope was a ~~laid~~ "laid" paper, while that last sent is a "wove" paper. And, moreover, the reason that we did not supply the "laid" envelopes is that there was so little sale for the "laid" envelopes that we have ceased carrying them in stock. We still have a few No. 8 in stock, and should have been only too pleased to let you have these, had we thought they would do; but we gave you the nearest we had to the sample you sent, and we are satisfied that anyone who understands papers will agree that the "wove" is much more in demand than the "laid" papers.

We regret, of course, that this shipment does not seem to have been entirely satisfactory, but can assure you that you have equal value.
