These trees were got from Toppinich Nursery Co.
Toppinich, Wash. & not from Tim Kelly & prob-
ably Kelly wont reply to you as I have the idea that he
is rather dissatisfied with his deal here last year,
why I dont know for on my own planting of his trees I lost
only 1%.

But with regard to your Newtowns, I bought them
in the Toppinich's storehouse myself Jan. 1909, they were
good & even after shipped here; I saw them about the
days they were reshipped to you from here & I could
see no blemish or disease on them whatever; it had
developed after planting, how how soon did you
irrigate this trees after planting? quite a little de-
pends on this for trees that have been a long time in
transit, If you are not too busy come up & see me I am
at Long Lake, have quit the Coldstream & am going back
to California next month, & as I got these trees for you
I shd. like if possible to explain give you all satisfaction
