

Minutes of adjourned hearing of the Court of Revision of the Winfield and Okanagan Centre Irrigation District held in the Winfield Community Hall, Thursday, November 20th 1930 at 10 o'clock A.M.

Members of the Court present, - Messrs. J. H. Aberdeen, James Goldie and J. E. Seaton.

Chairman, - Mr. J. E. Seaton, Secretary, - E. C. Maile.

Mr. G. D. Marshall, Manager of the Okanagan Valley Land Company submitted a list of "Town Lots" at Okanagan Centre owned by the said Company, which he wished to have classified so that they would be entitled to delivery of water both for domestic purposes and for garden irrigation.

The Court decided that they would take under consideration the whole matter of their jurisdiction over domestic water delivery and the particular circumstances connected with each lot at Okanagan Centre, and would make a ruling on this matter at a further sitting of the Court of which all interested parties would receive notice.

Thomas Williamson appeared in support of his appeal against the assessment of Lot 96 Map 444. The members of the Court having personally examined this lot, after hearing Mr. Williamson's arguments, ruled,

That the assessment of Lot 96 Map 444 be confirmed as 8. acres "A" and 2. acres "B".

Re Ore & Davidson, Lot 48 Map 444. The members of the Court having examined this property and being satisfied that an error had been made in the grading of the land, ruled,

That the assessment of Lot/48 Map 444 be amended to read 3.25 acres class "A" and .43 acres "B" in place of 1.5 acres "A" and 2.18 acres "B".

F. O. McDonald submitted evidence that an error had been made in the classification of Lot B Map 1555, and the Court ruled

That the assessment of Lot B. Map 1555 be amended to read 11.83 acres class "A" and 1.17 acres "B" in place of 10.3 acres "A" and 2.7 acres "B".

V. T. Allan's appeal against the assessment of Lot 95 Map 444 having been investigated by the members of the Court, it was ruled-

That the assessment of lot 95 Map 444 be amended to read 8.5 acres "A" and 1.73 acres "B" in place of 6 acres "A" and 4.23 acres "B".

J. R. Cheesman's appeal against the assessment of part Lot 13 Map 444 having been investigated by Mr. J. Goldie and by the assessor, the Court ruled

That the assessment of Lot 13 Map 444 (now described as Lot 3 plan 1657) be amended to read 8.5 acres class "A" and 2.9 acres "B" in place of 8. acres "A" and 3.4 acres "B".

Re Soldier Settlement Board, Lot 68 Map 444, the Court ruled

that the assessment of Lot 68 Map 444 be confirmed as 10. acres class "B".

Mr. J. H. Aberdeen submitted a resurvey of Lot 157 Map 498 which showed that an error had been made in computing the acreage of this lot, and the Court ruled,

That the assessment of Lot 157 Map 498 be amended to read Total 8.08 acres, Class "A" 8.08 acres.

The Court then adjourned.
