

Minutes of a Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Winfield and Okanagan Centre Irrigation District, held at the Winfield Packing House, Monday, November 2nd 1931 at 9.45 o'clock A.M.

Present: Messrs. Goldie, Read, McDonald and Gray, and the Secretary.

Mr. J. Goldie was appointed Chairman.

It was moved by Mr. McDonald,
Seconded by Mr. Gray,

That Mr. W. Read be appointed to the Court of Revision to be held today, in place of Mr. J. E. Seaton who is unable to be present.

Carried.

The Meeting then adjourned until the conclusion of the sitting of the Court of Revision.

On resuming the meeting of the Trustees, Mr. Pixton appeared before the Board to request their assistance in securing adjustment of matters between himself and the Okanagan Centre Irrigation and Power Company. Mr. Pixton states that the Company have failed to give him satisfactory service to his lot 57 Map 525 despite repeated complaints: he states that the pipe serving the upper part of this lot gave out some three years ago, and that the company refuse to renew it. Mr. Pixton contends that it is the duty of the Trustees to take action to protect the rights of the water users.

After considerable discussion of this point, and the principles involved, the Trustees present gave their opinion that it was not within the province of the Trustees to take up matters of this kind in dispute between the Irrigation Company and individual users.

No action was taken.

The Meeting then adjourned.
