The Water District of Winfield And Okanagan Centre is interested in a pumping plant to raise water out of a lake and delivering it into the natural channel.

We are trying to gather some information which will be useful when the question is raised, and we would be much obliged if you would let us have your advice as to the type of pump and engine necessary, and the probable cost. Also would it be possible to rent such an outfit for say three months.

The amount of water required is 10 Acre feet<sup>per day</sup>, or 5 Cubic Feet per second, and the lift, including friction is 10 Feet.

We might say that this is an emergency scheme, and it may not be necessary to use it again for some time.

Any advice or information that you can give us will be greatly appreciated.
