REGULATIONS AS TO THE SUPPLY AND DISTRIBUTION OF DOMESTIC AND IRRIGATION WATER

1. Irrigation rates are due and payable on the 1st day of May in each and every year; a discount of 5 per cent. will be allowed if the same are paid in full on or prior to said date.

2. No water for Irrigation will be supplied unless at least sixty per cent. of the rate has been paid, together with all arrears for 1929. The balance of the current year's rates payable by the 15th of July. On failure to make the said payment, the water will be shut off.

3. Any complaint as to any shortage of water must be made in writing to the Manager not later than ten days after the cause of such complaint arose. No complaint as to shortage of water will be entertained at the end of the season unless this rule has been complied with.

4. The Irrigation Company being only a conveyor of water under agreement will not be responsible for any shortage of water whene thresponsible for any shortage of water when th amount requested, but will furnish to all users equally up to one acre foot, the balance on an equal basis as requested prior to May 1st in each year.

5. Notice must be given if Domestic Water is not required, otherwise the regular rates will be due and payable and no rebate allowed.

6. The concessions granted as to discount for prompt payment and for extension of part payment shall not be considered to in any way affect the agreements entered into by the Company and the water users.

REGULATIONS AS TO THE SUPPLY AND DISTRIBUTION OF DOMESTIC AND IRRIGATION WATER

1. Irrigation rates are due and payable on the 1st day of May in each year and payable in full on or prior to said date. A discount of 5 per cent. will be allowed if the same are paid in full on or prior to said date.
2. No water for irrigation will be supplied unless at least sixty days before the rate has been paid, together with all arrears for 12 months. The balance of the current year's rates payable by the 15th of July. On failure to make the said payment, the water will be shut off.
3. Any complaint as to any shortage of water must be made in writing to the Manager not later than ten days after the cause of such complaint arose. No complaint as to shortage of water will be entertained at the end of the season unless this rule has been complied with.
4. The Irrigation Company and its conveyors of water under agreement will not be responsible for any shortage of water which is caused by any shortage of water when the amount requested, but will furnish to all users equally up to one acre foot, the balance on an equal basis as requested prior to the 1st of each year.
5. Notice must be given if water is not required, otherwise the regular rates will be due and payable and no rebate allowed.
6. The concessions granted as to discount for prompt payment and for extension of part payment shall not be considered to in any way reflect the agreements entered into by the Company and its water users.
