Dear Sirs:

We beg to acknowledge your wire of the 18th inst.

In reply, we beg to quote you upon h-m-p Petro-
lastic Asphalt a price of \$52.10 per ton, and on Refined Coal
Tar a price of 37¢ per gallon, both f.o.b. Winfield, B. C.
We have had no experience in actually using these materials
on flumes, but would think that it would take at least two
gallons to 100 sq.ft., as it is mopped on hot, and therefore
takes more than would a liquid preparation. The Asphalt
weighs about 10 lbs. to the gallon, and you can therefore
easily figure how much you would need for the amount of work
you are doing. We have a preparation which we call Liquigum,
which would be eminently satisfactory for your purpose. This
is a heavy liquid made from asphalt and asbestos fibre, and can
be put on cold with a brush without the bother and expense
of heating. It costs in barrels 88¢ per gallon, laid down at
Winfield. While the first cost is more than that of the
Asphalt and Tar, we think you will find it cheaper in the long
run, as you will not only not have the expense of heating it,
but also you will find that it will go much farther, covering
as it does about 100 sq.ft. to the gallon. If you wish us to
do so, we shall be glad to send you a small sample of this
material.
