The following is a list of the Bench Marks placed on the 26th May 1930. The elevations are from sea level, taking the surface of Wood's Lake as 1293 on the 26th of May. The elevation 1293 being derived from the official map called the Vernon Sheet.

- No.1, B.M. - nail in fence post on your eastern boundary El. 1582.27' 289.27
- No.2, B.M. Notch in Pine tree above 500ft West of East Bdy near Box at junction of flumes. El. 1617.48' 324.48
- No.3, B.M. on large Pine tree with dry top at the most southerly point of orchard El. 1654.93' *Lateral L.* 361.93
- No.4, B.M. Top of rounded stone in ground and partly exposed about 6ft West of Box on south bdy about 1100ft west of No.3, B.M. El. 1646.24' 353
- No.5, B.M. top of nail on stump at highest point of road El. 1576.99' 281.5
- No.6, B.M. nail in apple tree east of spray tank El. 1535.4' 242
- Spot level near stump on flat, east of Baseball field, EL. 1507.77 214
