Reopening of the Court of Revision (adjourned on Nov. 27, 1947) in the office of the Rainbow Ranche on Friday, March 14, 1947, at 3.30pm.

PRESENT :- J. E. Seaton (Chairman) Messrs. Chase, Duggan, & Goldie.

The Court of Revision was reopened to consider the application by N. Davy to restore water rights on two acres of Lot 50, Map 444. The rights on 5.8 acres of this property had been cancelled at the request of the then owner, W. W. Robinson, at the Court of Revision in 1932.

After much discussion it was

MOVED by CHASE

SECONDED by DUGGAN :- " That the decision on Mr. Davy's request for the restoration of water rights on two acres of Lot 50, Map 444, be deferred until the first general meeting of the new Trustees. This in order that a full Board might discuss & vote on the matter.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Mr. Davy being present at the latter part of the Court proceedings ( by invitation ) this resolution was conveyed to him in person.

The Court adjourned at 4. pm.
