We are trying to gather some information that will be useful when the question is raised, and we would be much obliged if you would let us have your advice as to the type of engine and pump necessary, and the probable cost. Also would it be possible to rent such an outfit for say three months.


The amount of water required is 10 acre feet per day, or 5 cubic feet per second. The lift including friction is 10 feet.

We might say that this is an emergency scheme and it may not be necessary to use it again for some time.
