Dear Sirs :-

The Winfield & Okanagan Centre Irrigation District is interested in a pumping plant for the purpose of raising water out of a lake and delivering it into the natural channel.

We are trying to secure some information which will be useful when the question is raised. We would be much obliged if you would let us have your advice as to the type of pump and engine necessary, and the probable cost. Also would it be possible to rent such an out fit for say three months.

The amount of water required is 10 acre feet per day, or 5 cubic feet per second. The lift, including friction is 10 feet.

We might say that this is an emergency scheme and may not be used again for some time.

Any advice or information that you can give us will be greatly appreciated .
