## ANOTHER RAILROAD FOR NORTHERN CANADA

OTTAWA.—Notice has been given that an application will be made to parliament at the next session for an act incorporating a railway company under the name of the Pacific Trans-Canada & Hudson Bay Railway Co. to construct a road from Edmonton to Athabasca Landing, thence around Lesser Slave Lake to Wabasca or Loon River, thence to the junction of the Loon and Peace rivers, near Fort Vermillion, and to other points in the north, eventually reaching Prince Rupert or the Portland canal in British Columbia. The capitalization or officers of the proposed line are not named in the notice.

## PROPOSE NATURAL PARK AND CITY WATERSHED

The water department has sent out surveyors to inspect the land included in the offer of S A Moore of 5,000 acres of land on the Seymour, to which a good route is possible from the present intake, with a view to adding a large watershed for an enlarged water supply for Vancouver, and for forming a natural park. The cost of Mr. Moore's property to the city will be \$170,000.

## CONTRACT LET ON OFFICE BUILDING

Archit W A Doctor, 322 Metropolitan bldg, has awarded the contract for the construction of the Hudson Bay Insurance Co bldg, to be located on Hastings st near Hornby, to Contractor Schultz, who will erect the bldg on a percentage basis. This will be an office bldg, 26x120, 2 stories in height, and of brick with stone facings, to cost \$26,000.

## WILL ERECT HOUSE ON SHAUGHNESSY HEIGHTS

Archts MacLure & Fox, Pacific bldg, are taking tenders from selected contractors only, for the construction of a 2-story and basement frame residence for Shaughnessy Hts. The house will contain 8 rooms and will be 70x33. Basement of concrete and hot water heating. The general contract will include all minor contracts.

## WILL REPAIR LARGE CITY RESERVOIR

VICTORIA.—The council has instructed the city engineer to make estimates and prepare specifications for the repair of the Smith Hill reservoir, which has been leaking badly. This is a reservoir 340 ft square, and is constructed of concrete.

## HOUSE FOR POINT GREY

Archts Gamble & Knapp, 615 Hastings at W, have completed plans for a 2-story frame residence for Point Grey rd, owned by Vernon Bros, 570 Granville st, who will erect the house. This residence is the fourth of ten proposed in the same neighborhood by the same owners, the others to be constructed one at a time. Work is now progressing on two others.

## WANTS SUGGESTIONS ON PROPOSED CITY HALL

Acting Mayor Ramsey has sent out an invitation to the citizens of Vancouver to make suggestions of any character with reference to the proposed \$1,000,000 city hall. On account of the overcrowded condition of the present city hall it will soon be necessary to engage other quarters to house some of the departments, and members of the council consider a new bldg preferable to using other quarters.

## VICTORIA PROPOSES CITY EXTENSION

VICTORIA.—A proposal has been made by the mayor to the council for the extension of the city limits to include sections 25, 26 and 27, of the municipality of South Saanich and a portion of Oak Bay. The proposed extension would bring the fair grounds within the city limits. It is probable that an election will have to take place before the scheme can be carried through.

## WANTS TENDERS ON SHAUGHNESSY HTS HOUSE

Archit R P S Twizell, 1019 Metropolitan bldg, is calling for tenders for the general contract for a residence for W G Secord, on Shaughnessy Hts, to cost about \$4,900. ## NO PLANS AS TO HUDSON BAY DEPARTMENT STORE

Although it has been announced that the Hudson Bay Co would erect a large department store building in this city, it is reported at the present time that plans have been delayed, and that the building will not be erected for 18 months at least. Whether there will be a competition for the plans, or a direct award has not yet been stated.

## UNIT CONTRACT LET IN SEATTLE

SEATTLE.—A A Phinney of the Phinney Realty Co, Leary bldg, states that he has awarded the contract for the first unit of the proposed 12-story bldg for 1st ave, near Marion st, to the Stone & Webster Engineering Corporation. All minor contracts are included. The bldg will be 3 stories in height. Designed by W Marbury Somervell of Seattle and Vancouver.

## STATUS OF G T P BUILDING APPROACH

It has been decided by the committee of the city council, that the matter of an overhead approach to the G T P dock and proposed buildings, will be included in the general scheme of crossings over the railroad tracks, as laid out by the railroad commission. Several schemes for the approach have been proposed, but none as yet which meets with the approval of the committee, the railroad and the property owners in the vicinity.

TACOMA.—It is reported the Schubert Bros, theatrical managers, have secured a site on Pacific ave near 9th st, and will erect a showhouse there.

## CHURCH FOR SOUTH SIDE

The Central Christian Church will erect a small 1-story frame church at 1616 11th ave W, after the design of J D Smedley. The contract has been awarded to the Acme Co, 1276 Granville st.
