A trial run

OF THE BIG CRUSHER.

LOTS OF VISITORS.

Mother Lode, Sat. April 26—The first preliminary test on a large scale of the new crusher was made today, when three, three-ton cars of ore were run through.

There was not a hitch in the working of the machine during the entire run, and the big rocks were crushed as though they were mere eggshells. However, the machinery being so new and a little stiff in its joints, it requires cautious running at first.

On Sunday over 20 tons of ore were sent through the crusher without the bearings getting very hot. On both days there were crowds of visitors watching the progress of events. It is expected that every thing will be in perfect running condition by Wednesday.
