ONE WAGON BRIDGE AND 3  
FOOT BRIDGES GONE.

SIDEWALK A FLOAT.

Sunday, May 11, 1902—Last night the Creek was near to the level of the flat at Anaconda. It rained all night and in the morning it was over the flat.

The bridge by the smelter pump house is gone, together with two foot bridges in Greenwood and one in Anaconda.

The bridge by the S. E. G. Store is on a level with the water. The men watching the bridge drove in long spikes to hold it down.

The water has torn out fences and flooded houses on the Creek side of Gold St.
