## THE SMELTER.

### At Boundary Falls.

#### SECOND FURNACE NEARLY READY. THIRD ORDERED.

On Monday morning the editor visited the Boundary Falls smelter, and found that the second furnace had the water jacket in place and is now ready to be bricked in.

In the engine room the foundations are being put in for the new boilers and blower. Above the boilers coal bunkers will be put in, and a coal bin is being built in under the railway track and between the bents.

A locomotive and slag pots have been ordered and the slag will be handled liquid, thus economizing their dump ground.

The third furnace has been ordered.
