A VISIT TO THE GOLD BUG

THE EDITOR

Sees great things.

On Friday last the editor, accompanied by Mr. T. A. Garland, visited the Gold Bug. There are half a dozen tunnels, a shaft, and a number of open cuts. The ledge is present in them all. \$5,000.00 have been taken from a cut 20 feet long and wide and six to ten feet deep. The ore assays about \$100.00 per ton after deducting freight and treatment.

Mr. D. A. Holbrook is tracing the ledge down the hill towards the railway track, and has ore in every open cut except the last one, where he expected to have it in another round. This last cut is within 100 feet of the railway. Little grading will be necessary to put in a railway spur for ore shipments.

Mr. McAllister of the Anaconda smelter arrived in town yesterday evening.
