Mr. D. A. Holbrook is tracing the ledge down the hill towards the railway track, and has ore in every open cut except the last one, where he expeced to have it in another round. This last cut is within 100 feet of the railway. Little grading will be necessary to put in a railway spur for ore shipments.
