BOUNDARY CREEK RISING FAST

NEW BRIDGE.

Near lower railway trestle.

The hot weather which began on Saturday and the continuous rains have caused the creek to rise until it is now within a few feet of high water mark. Should this weather continue a flood may be expected.

The new bridge, which has been built to replace the old one directly below town, is nearly completed. It was feared that the former bridge would go out with this year's floods. The new bridge is much higher, and is now one of the best on the creek.

At trestle No. 92 A the water is over the entire flat, and within a foot of the top of the cribbing built to protect the bridge piles. A strong current is running through the piles, and on the near side of the trestle a second current is running through the flat.
