## Granby Smelter

### Many New things going on there.

At the Granby smelter at Grand Forks, much construction work is going on at present. Tracks for the slag railway are being laid and will be ready when the locomotive arrives. Most of the slag cars are on the ground, in readiness for use. The locomotive will probably arrive in about a month. This system of dumping slag will be put into active operation as soon as possible after the locomotive comes in.

Six furnaces are now in place. Of these four are now running. The others will be blown in as soon as the hot slag railroad is in operation.

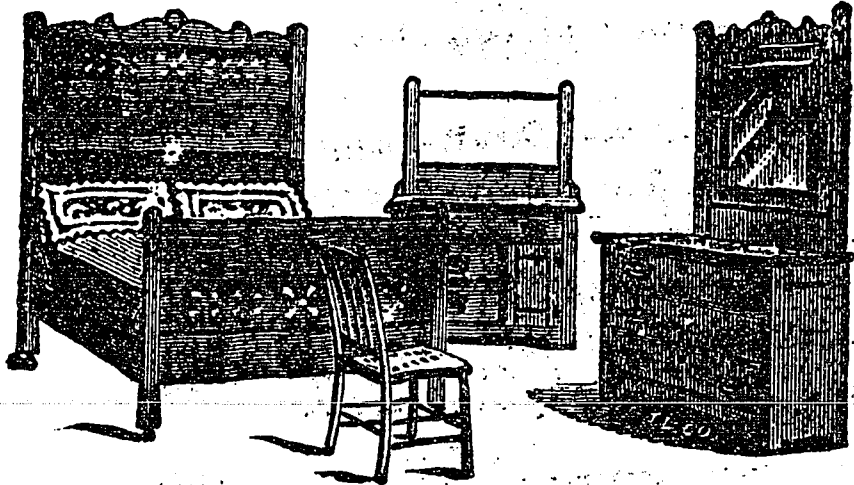
