Another Wreck.

On C. P. R. at Boundary Falls.

Tuesday, October 27—A wreck occurred on the C. P. R., as the result of a misplaced switch, at Boundary Falls early this morning. Of a train of 13 cars, two cars were off the track. Between was another that did not leave the rails. It is a mystery as to how it could stay on the track, with a car off in front and another off behind it. All the cars were loaded with ore, which made it harder to rerail them. The cars did not have to be unloaded.

There was a locomotive on each end of the cars, but only the one on the Anaconda side could work on the

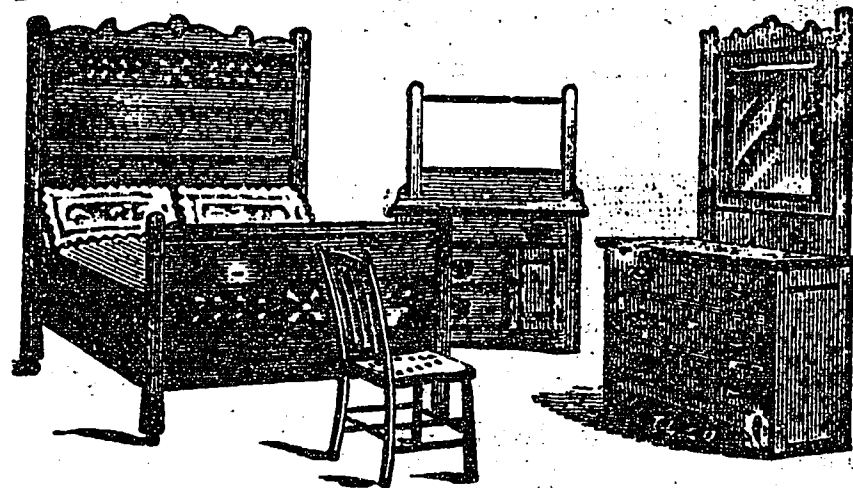
