## New Things

### At the B. C. Copper Co. smelter.

At the Anaconda smelter construction work is being pushed. The slag is being taken out hot from both sides of both furnaces. The iron trestle has been filled solid with slag, and the track has been pushed over so as to give more dump. A new grade has been made around the hillside below the tank, and another track will shortly be laid, so as to furnish more dump ground for hot slag.

The converter dust flue is finished and arched roof completed. The transformer building is finished. The poles for the power line are all up, but the wires are not yet strung. Timbers are being cut and squared for the electric power house.

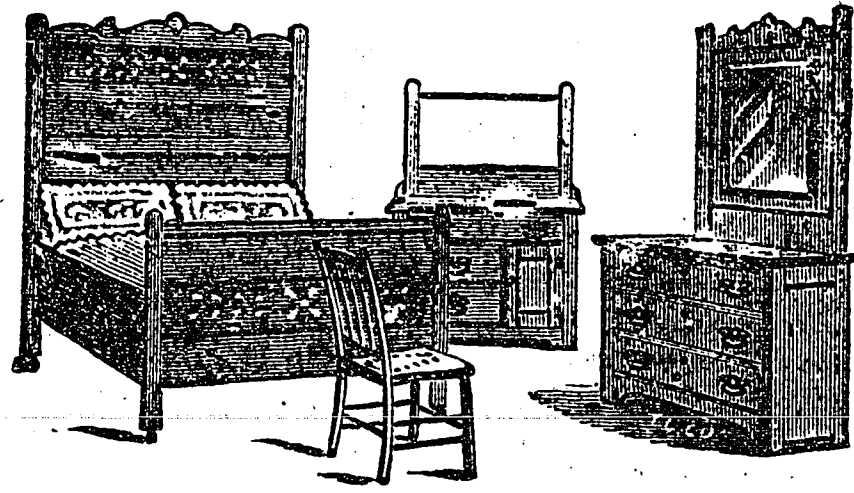
