## New Things

### At the B. C. Copper Co's smelter.

At the B. C. Copper Co's smelter construction work is getting along well.

The new electric power plant building is completed. This building is of wood with a corrugated iron roof. The foundations for the electric machinery are nearly finished. Only three remain to be completed. Half of the immense fly wheel of the converter blower is in position; the other half is in the building in readiness to be put in place. Most of the blowing engine is set up. Excavations are being made for two more motors. These will be near to the old power house and will run the blowers now in use. The partition between the new and old power houses is partly torn down.

The steel converter building is finish

ed. The only wooden things about this building are the window frames.

The new Spokane slag bowls are lasting very well. The shells are pried out with crowbars instead of pounding as heretofore. This method is a great improvement over the old one.

## Cold Snaps

### Three cold days so far-- --8 on Jan 26.

THREE cold snaps are on record for this winter to date. Each was of one day's duration. The day before and the day after were always cold but warmer than the intermediate day. The first of these cold snaps was early in the winter. The thermometer did not get below zero.

The second was on January 26th. It was the coldest of the winter with the mercury at -8.

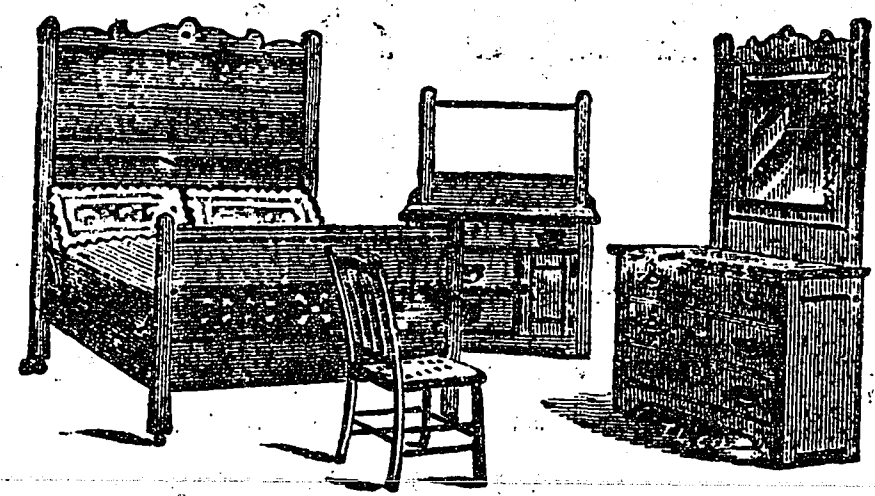
