## Construction

### Practically finished at smelter.

At the B.C. Copper Co's smelter the construction work is almost finished. All is now ready for the machinery.

The runways from the matte elevator to the clay and quartz bins are nearly finished. The lower is boarded over and the ties are in place on the upper.

The trenches for the belts that will connect the present blowers with the electric motors are finished and lined with boards. All the stone machinery foundations in the new engine room are completed. The converter foundations are also finished. The slag has backed up a considerable pond in Copper Creek gulch. This dump will soon be all the way across the gulch.

A second meeting of the Anaconda citizens will be held tonight in the ol-

office of the B. C. Copper Co. on Butte Ave. to discuss the Lind Creek water problem.

## Mining Exhibit.

At the St. Louis Fair the Palace of Mines will measure 525 by 750 feet, and will cost \$498,000.

The ancient Carrizo copper mine of Mexico will be reproduced. Its shaft will have chicken ladders, up which the ore will be carried on the backs of Aztecs, crushed on stones, sorted into trays, and carried to the roaster; then to the adobe furnace where it is smelted by means of hand worked bellows. The matte is run into holes lined with charcoal, which converts it into blister copper 85 per cent pure. A blast furnace further refines it to 98 per cent copper. The ingots are beaten into vases. The wonderful coloring is supplied by Jesus Cabano, who alone holds the old Incas secret. While smoking

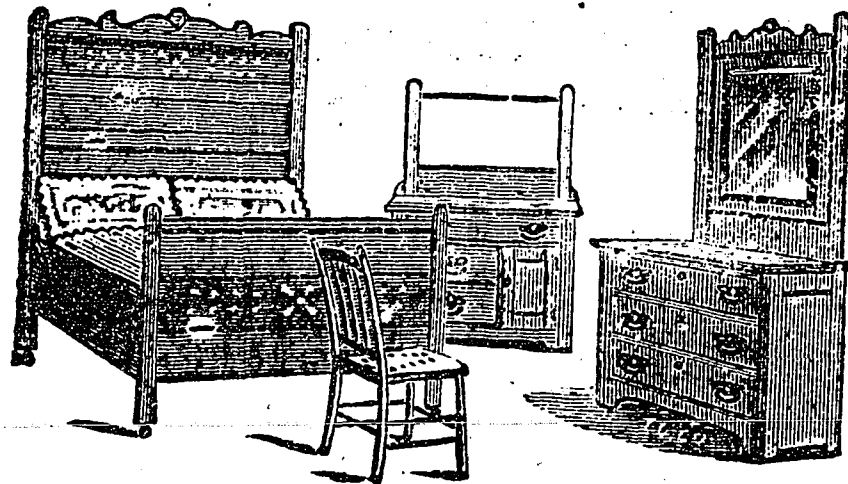
