Smelter News.

Slag Railway--Silica & Clay mill.

ON the slag railway at the B. C. Copper Co's smelter many improvements have been made. The tracks have been made as substantial as is possible when they are constantly being moved. The dump into Copper Creek is over half way across the gulch. When this is all the way across, a grade will be made along the side of the mountain on the west. A track will be laid down this, and the slag dumped over the hill. This will give an immense slag dump. The round slag-bowls from Spokane are lasting very well, but few repairs having as yet been made on them.

Two runways have been built from the matte elevator to the new bins.

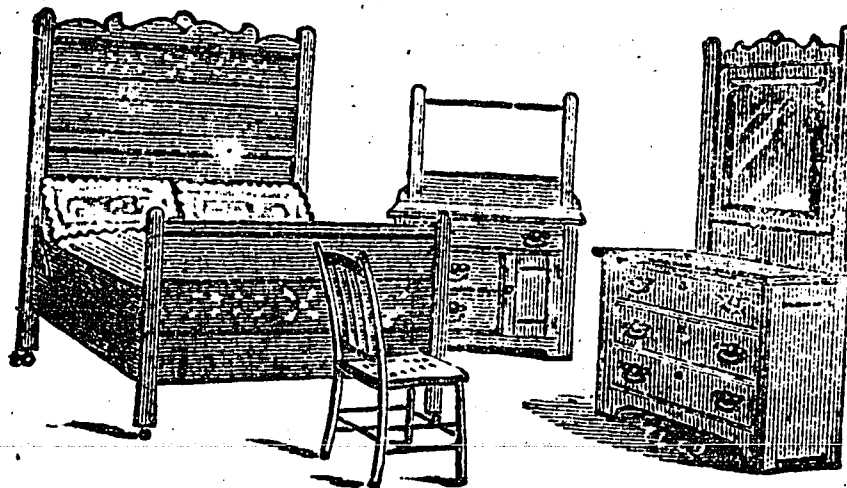

One, the nearest to the top, is to supply quartz to the silica mill where it will be crushed for use. The other and lower one is to supply the clay bins. This runs directly to the bin, as the clay does not need crushing. Most of the silica mill machinery has arrived, and will be put up as soon as is possible.

The foundations for the electric machinery are nearly finished.
