The lead encountered at the Providence on the 300 foot level is rich in ruby silver, and contains good gold values. Samples from it are a sight to behold.

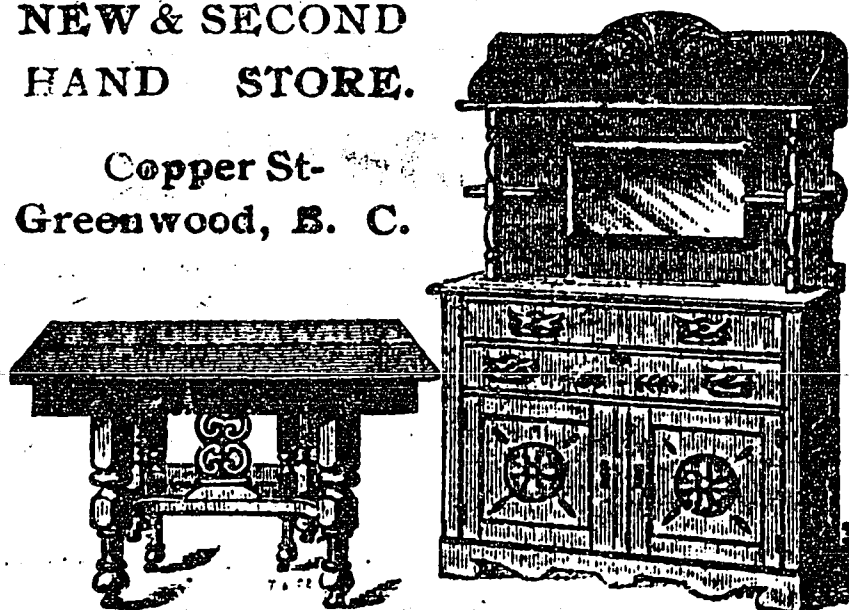
Mr. Fowler is preparing to resume development work on the Defiance. It is likely to make a shipper of the richest ore in the camp by fall or early winter.
