FOREST FIRE.

Breaks Out in Woods Below Anaconda-- Property Burned.

A large and very destructive forest fire started on Sunday about noon from an unknown cause near the old No. 7 siding.

Between Anaconda and Boundary Falls the woods were mainly composed of small, scrubby pine and fir. Many of these were killed by smelter smoke and others blown over by the heavy storms last year. The fallen ones formed a dry brush several feet thick and the rest more or less dry wood above.

The fire spread north and south from its starting point and soon jumped the creek to start a new fire there. This traveled out of the valley and up the

mountain on the east, causing the loss of fine timber and cord wood.

On Monday the fire, after burning all night, was still going. All of the forest on the east side of the creek up to the foot of the mountains, and in some places on the mountains, from Boundary Falls to the second bridge below here was burnt. From the Boundary Falls smelter dam up to near the first bridge south of Anaconda the forest on the west of the creek is almost totally destroyed.

A force of men commenced fighting the fire on Tuesday, and, much assisted

At the Junebug, south of Anaconda, the men who have the bond have struck good looking gold ore. It is being developed by a tunnel.

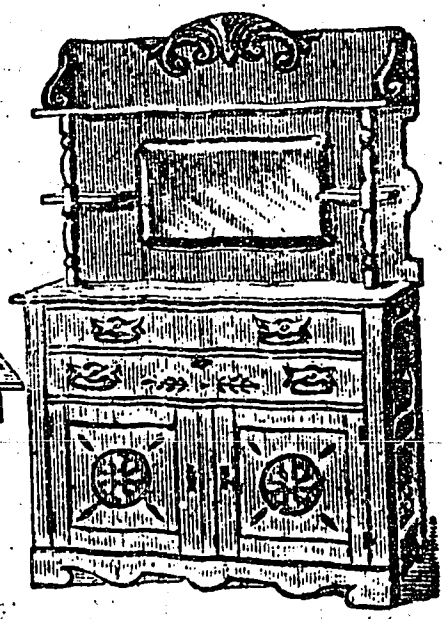
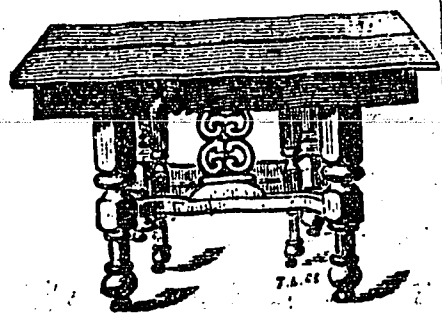
Bannerman and partner have struck a promising prospect in Long Lake Camp. It has a fine lead of rich gold ore.
