This work will give a large space in which will be placed crushers, ore bins, engines and other machinery.

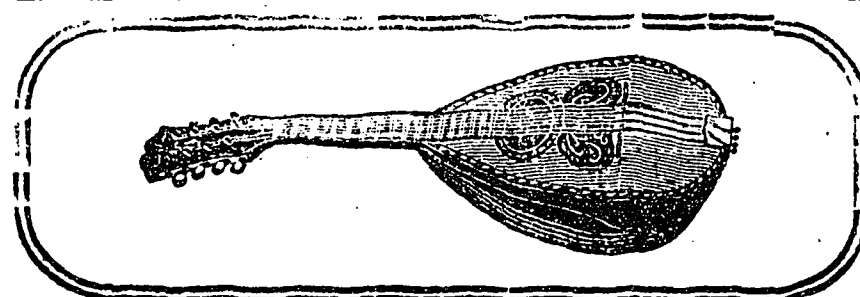

The Helen is improving with development. Some of the richest ore ever found in the camp is being sacked at present.

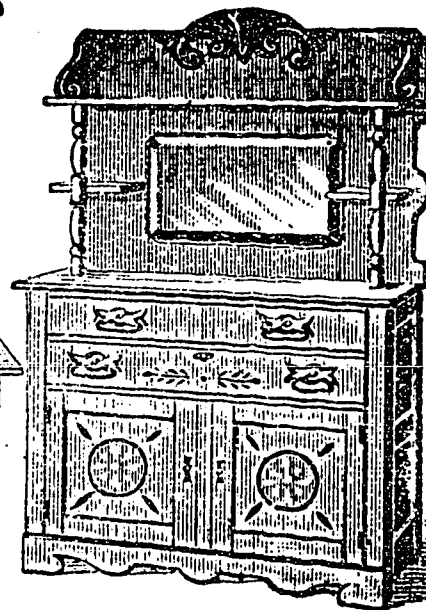
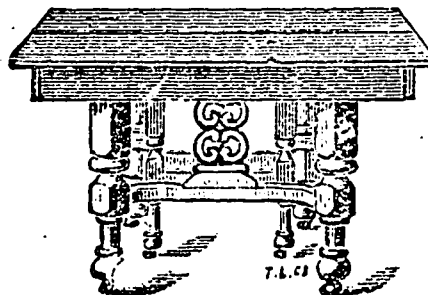
From the E. P. U. a carload of very rich ore was shipped last week to Nelson.
