BIG FLOODS.

Water six feet two inches over low water mark. Much damage done.

First day.

Creek Higher than Ever Before.

Friday, April 15th, 9.00 A. M.—On this morning the creek measured 3 ft. 10 in. above low water mark, making a rise of 11 inches over night. A rainfall of one and an eighth inches added to the rise. Twin Creek overflowed Greenwood streets to a depth of two to three inches.

10.00 A. M.

The B. C. Copper Co's cribbing above the pump house was flooded over

Second day

Creek Lowered Some-- Damage.

Saturday, April 16, 7.15 A. M.—This morning the creek marked 5 ft. 4 in. over low water. One of the foot bridges at the Denver Ave. crossing was turned completely over, the foot bridge from the pump house lodging on top.

Copper Creek was in the channel that it made the day before, but had nearly ceased washing in slag. This enabled Boundary Creek to break the slag dam and return to its old channel. No wagon bridges went out below here.

a foot deep.

All this time Copper Creek was a tremendous torrent, and was much larger than Boundary Creek is at low water. It washed out a railway fill this side of Deadwood on the Mother Lode spur, causing much delay. Lind Creek was very high, and dangerously near the railway track.

11.00 A. M.

At the lower railway trestle the entire flat was under water. On the northern end of the railway span the water was over the C. P. R.'s stone filled cribbing, within eight inches of the top of the piles supporting the span. On the southern end the water had not reached the top of the wall. This wall was doing very good work. Mr. Bombeni's ranch was partly flooded.

2.30 P. M.

At this time Copper Creek began to change its channel. The new one was

located in the granulated slag dump. The slag, washed down into the creek, formed a dam which backed up the water and caused the main channel to shift next to the hill which faces the creek on the east. Boundary Creek was up to 5 ft. 5 in. over low water. At this time the foot bridge at the pump house went out.

3.00 P. M.

The cribbing below the smelter pump went down. A great many fences were washed out and Mr. Keffer's chicken house went off its foundations, drowning many chickens.

4.00 P. M.

At this time the creek was higher than then it has been for seven years. The water had backed up behind the road to the C. P. R. station. Efforts were being made to save the road. The creek at five o'clock was 6 ft. 2 in. above low water, which was a long way above extreme high water to date.

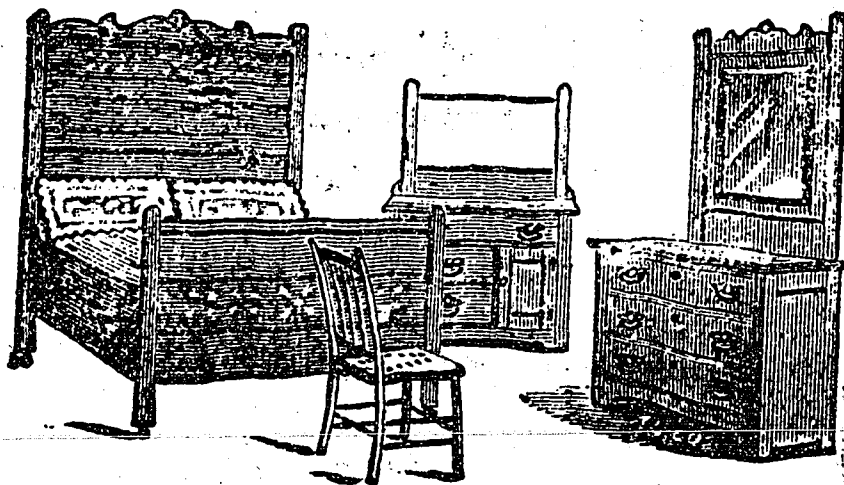
MINING NOTES.
