SUMMER

Hottest Since 1897-Season Month Ahead.

The past season has been extraordinary in many ways. Everything is at least a month ahead of last year. High water came in early April instead of late in May as usual and the creek is now down at low water. This is nearly a month before the ordinary time.

The first week entirely without rain or snow in 1904 was that just passed. The coldest night since March was June 23rd., when the thermometer got down to 29 Fahr. The warmest day so far was Thursday last when the mercury reached 98 in the shade in some parts of Greenwood. This has been and promises to be the hottest summer since 1897.

Another strange feature of this summer has been the extraordinary number of heavy thunder storms. These usually came from about three P. M.

to midnight following a very hot morning.

The fruit season is also much ahead of that of last year. We should have a good crop of sweet corn.

TIMBERING

Will Soon Begin on the Helen.

At the Helen the shaft is now down about 70 feet. The lead is still ten inches wide and is increasing in value.

Timbers are being squared preparatory to timbering up the new portion of the shaft, which is down over twenty feet, with square sets. The thirty foot drift connecting the old shaft with the new will also be timbered.

A shipment of fifty sacks of rich ore was made last week. It is hoped that this ore will go at least \$200.00 to the ton. The Helen promises to make one of the richest of the high grade mines of the Boundary.
