PROGRESS

Of Development on Lulu & Moonshine.

Work is steadily progressing on Mr. W. S. McDonald's two properties half way between here and Boundary Falls on the hill to the east.

On the Lulu, which is the farthest south of the group, two holes have been sunk on the lead. The shaft farthest south is down ten feet. No work has been done on it recently. The other shaft is now down 15 feet. The lead is two feet thick at the bottom and is well mineralized with galena.

Several crosscuts have been made on the lead on the surface. These cut the ledge at intervals for over a hundred feet. In these surface cuts the ore body is only a few inches thick and not mineralized. However, at the depth of fifteen feet it is two feet through and carries good values.

NATURAL FREAK

Large Tree half Spruce and half Fir.

The editor found a curious tree on the road to the Lulu, below here, some time ago.

The tree is a red fir about 75 feet high and seems to be in good health. Two thirds up the tree on the uphill side is a dense growth of very dark spruce. This spruce is a part of the fir, and appears to grow from a lump on the side of it. The tree stands on a round mound of earth separated from the rest of the mountain and is not surrounded by other trees but stands alone and is very conspicuous even from a distance on account of the difference in color between the top which is pale yellow and the middle which is almost black.

This tree is but a short walk from Anaconda over a good road and is on Mr. W. S. McDonald's ranch.

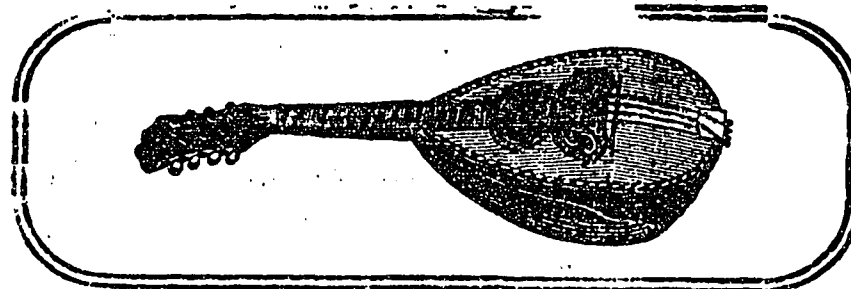
