GOOD SHOWING

On the Silver Cloud at present.

On the Silver Cloud work is being pushed.

The shaft, which is now down thirty feet, is all ore all the way. The lead is several feet, with a pay streak of four inches in the center. This pay streak assays over \$400.00 and the rest about \$25.00 per ton. So far the work has all been done with the pick, as the ground is much weathered owing to the flatness of the ledge. The lead has been traced on the Silver Cloud for 800 feet.

About ten tons of first class ore has been sacked up, and they expect to make a shipment of a carload in about three weeks. The second class ore is being piled on the dump for future shipment.

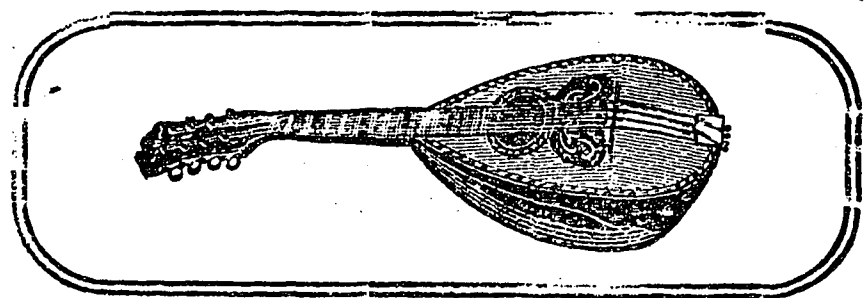

Caught in Trestle.

On Sunday morning about dawn a yellow horse, one of the Rodrick Dhu pack train, fell through the C. P. R. trestle at Anaconda. A train coming later was flagged and stopped. About half past eight several men arrived. A rope was then secured with which the horse's feet were tied together and to his head. He then was rolled over and

over until the end of the bridge was reached. Help arrived from the C.P.R. station as the horse was being rolled off the end of the bridge. The animal was not seriously hurt.

The Silver King.

Work is progressing on the Silver King. The shaft, which is near the Silver Cloud line, is being sunk. Differing from the Silver Cloud, it is in what is pronounced to be the hardest ground in B. C. The lead here is showing up well.
