NEW THINGS

Being done at the Local Smelter.

At the B. C. Copper Co.'s smelter the new briquetting plant building is almost completed. The foundations for the plant are in and the machinery is expected daily. This plant is situated on the coke floor above the old engine room.

On the slag railway surveys have been made for the extension of the line on the west side. A ballasted track has been laid across the Copper Creek dump and an iron trestle built between this dump and the hill on the west. Two new switches have been put in connecting the new track with the main dump and forming a "Y". This new track also makes a considerable short cut between the main dump and No. 2 furnace. A new shed has been built over the railway scales.

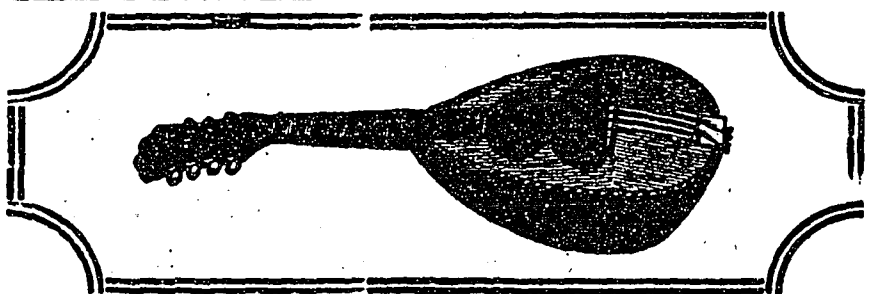
