The Steam Turbine.

The last word seems to have been spoken with regard to steam power. The new steam turbine engine which attracted so much attention at St. Louis has already become a practical force in many new steamships.

At St. Louis the largest example was a 3000 horse power engine so compact that it occupied no more space than an old fashioned 40 horse power engine, and ran so smoothly that there was no sound and no perceptible vibration. The dynamo that was attached to it, however, was running with a deafening roar.

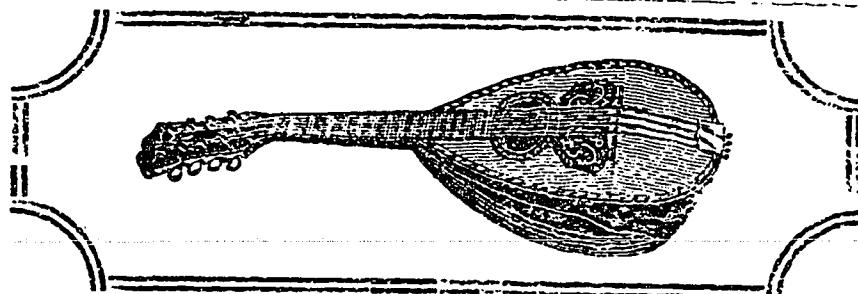

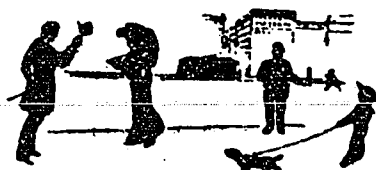
