OVER 35 MEN WORK ON PROVIDENCE

Big Force Start Drifts on 400 on Monday—Have a 90 H. P. Boiler—Will soon Install 10 Drill Compressor.

AT the PROVIDENCE 35 men started work Monday morning drifting north and south on the lead on the 400 foot level. Drifting and stoping are also being done in the south tunnel on the 300 foot level.

The new 90 horse power boiler is working splendidly. The boiler uses wood, of which there is an abundant supply near at hand, for fuel. It is intended to put in an air compressor of a capacity of between seven and ten drills in the near future. At present two steam drills are being used. The force of miners will be increased continually so as to have over fifty men employed by the time the new compressor is installed.

Messrs. Madden, Heeney and Fitzgerald of the board of directors left for Chicago on Saturday last, where they will likely place an order for the compressor plant. They were much pleased with the mine, especially the 400 foot level, where there is a foot of high grade ore. The shaft is to be sunk to the 500 foot level soon. Large shipments will be resumed in a few weeks.

STRATHMORE

Will soon Strike Ore in Long Tunnel—Vein 18 Inch

THE editor was a visitor at the STRATHMORE mine on Monday of this week.

At this property four men are employed driving the tunnel which is now in over 300 feet. It is expected that the ore body will be struck in a short distance.

About 75 feet up the hill from the mouth of the tunnel is a 65 foot shaft. From the 35 foot level of this shaft a south drift has been run 60 or 70 feet on the vein, which is here 18 inches

HIGHLAND QUEEN

Tunnel in 30 feet—New Lead Found in Open Cut

AT the HIGHLAND QUEEN much work has been done since the last visit of the editor on April 14th. (for description and map of mine see The News for April 19th, Vol. 5, No. 19).

The new tunnel at the bottom of the cliff is now in 35 feet. The main lead should be encountered very shortly. This ledge has been recently exposed on the surface for a distance of 330 feet, and shows up well in each cutting. A twenty foot shaft has been sunk 120 feet from the northern end

thick. A large amount of ore has been stoped out from this point, and a car-load is at present ready for shipment. At the bottom of this shaft the ore body faulted, and was recovered only after a 70 foot drift to the east. The new tunnel will give much depth on the vein and open up a large stoping ground.

The ore is silver-lead and carries from \$20 to \$30 in gold, making a total value of over \$100 per ton high grade and \$25 to \$30 second class. The walls, both hanging and foot, are very well defined on the STRATHMORE, and point to a constant vein.

Names of mining properties appearing in The News will hereafter be set in SMALL CAPITALS.

The north end of Greenwood should have a boom in the near future, with 35 men working at the PROVIDENCE and the ELKHORN to start up soon.

of the cutting, and at several other places holes have been run in on the ore for several feet. This lead averages from a foot to thirty six inches in thickness.

At a point 45 feet east of the main ore body a new ledge has been uncovered for a distance of 300 feet. This ore is a new discovery and is as large or larger than the western body. Some very nice ore has been taken out of these new surface drifts. This lead is parallel with the old vein and has the same dip. It will probably be encountered in the tunnel at a distance of 40 to 50 feet from the first lead.

A good trail has been built to this property from Anaconda by way of the MOUNTAIN QUEEN and the former Anaconda powder house.
