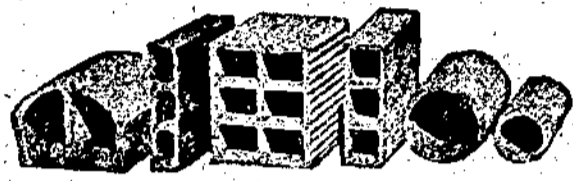

BUNGALOW IN POINT GREY

ow to be erected in West Point Grey

TO START WORK SOON ON

NEW CORDAGE FACTORY

NEW WESTMINSTER.—Announce-
ment was made by Capt. O. B. Eller,
manager of the Western Cordage Com-
pany, a new organization composed of
returned soldiers, that it had been de-
finitely decided to locate the proposed
\$100,000 cordage factory and plant in
the Royal City. The company, which
has been duly incorporated with a
capital stock of \$300,000, of which the
returned men have already put up
\$60,000 in cash, expects to be in a po-
sition to call for tenders for the main
building of the plant in a couple of
weeks at the most.

The company also expects to re-
ceive within the next few days the first
instalment of the \$200,000 loan which
they will receive from the Provincial
Government under the provisions of the
Industrial Development Act. Orders
have already been placed in the
East for the most modern machinery
and equipment for a cordage plant,
but it is not expected that deliveries
of machinery will be received for at
least six months. The interval, how-
ever, will be employed in getting the
factory erected and all ready to instal
the machinery when it arrives. The
plant will provide work for between
80 and 90 men, and there are consid-
erable orders already in sight.

HOMES IN FORTNIGHT

NEW WESTMINSTER.—The spe-
cial civic housing committee has pre-
pared a report for submission to the
city council at its next meeting, show-
ing that everything is now practically
in readiness for a commencement by
the city on the erection of the new
dwellings under the Soldier Housing
Act. There are a few minor details
and technicalities to be arranged with
the Provincial Government, and
Mayor Gray plans to visit the capital
about the end of the week to clear
up these matters with the cabinet, so
that the housing scheme can be put
into effect within the next fortnight
anyway.

MEMORIAL HALL CAMPAIGN

SOUTH VANCOUVER.—Complete
reorganization has been effected in the

SOUTH VANCOUVER.—As a result

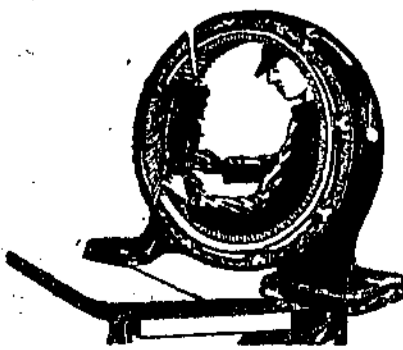

WINNIPEG RIVER POWER PLANT WINNIPEG.—The Winnipeg River Power Company has started constructing a huge power plant at Du Bonnet Falls, on the Winnipeg River, 75 miles northeast of Winnipeg. The project, which will be completed in two years, will cost between \$6,000,000 and \$7,000,000. The company, which is closely allied with the Winnipeg Electric Railway Company, intends not only to sell power to this company, but to develop an extensive power business in towns throughout Manitoba.
