DOMINION CANNERIES, LTD. MAKE NEW ADDITIONS
Architect A. E. Henderson, 39-40 Davis Chambers Building, has awarded a contract to S. J. Hewitt, 954-17th W., for the construction of a new galvanized iron boiler house and other improvements at the plant of the Dominion Canneries, Ltd., on Front Street. The new addition and improvements will cost \$4,900.

ARCHITECT ASKS FOR TENDERS FOR ROTARY CLINIC
Architect J. A. Benzie, 429 Standard Bank Bldg., is asking for tenders for the construction of the Rotary Clinic. General Trades, Plumbing and Heating will be asked for separately.

PORT HAMMOND NOTES.

The Port Hammond Cedar Mill Company are kept busy pumping, but otherwise have not yet been inconvenienced by the rising waters of the Fraser. The company are making extensive additions to their plant, which, when completed, will double the capacity of their shingle and lumber mill output.

TRAIL NOTES.

An unconfirmed rumor is afloat that Trail has been selected as the site for the new steel plant that is to be erected in Western Canada with assistance in the way of bonuses from the Federal and Provincial Government. The reason given is that it is in close proximity to the largest body of suitable iron ore in British Columbia.

BIG SAWMILL TO BE BUILT

PORTLAND, Ore.—A sawmill with a capacity of 1,000,000 feet a day, and in other respects equipped to make it the largest mill on the Pacific Coast, and probably second largest in the country, has been designed in Portland, for the United States Government, as part of its spruce production programme. The mill will be erected on the Olympic peninsula on the shore of Lake Pleasant, near Beaver, in Clallam County, Wash., and about 50 miles west of Port Angeles.

BUILDING NEWS FROM SEATTLE

\$58,455 ROAD CONTRACT LET
SEATTLE.—The board of King county commissioners yesterday awarded to the J. A. Fletcher Co., Luzerne Apartments, the contract to pave 2.31 miles of permanent highway No. 18, beginning at the south limits of Kent and running thence north toward Orilla, on a bid of \$58,455.20.

Approximately 27,326 square yards of one-course paving will be laid.
The bids received for the paving of permanent highway No. 18 follow:

County engineer's estimate 57,979.43
No bids were received in response to the county's call for the paving of permanent highway No. 19 (Tolt-Falls City project), estimated by the county engineer to cost \$25,000.

CALL BIDS ON 77 MILES OF IDAHO HIGHWAYS
Bids are officially called by the State Highway Commission of Idaho, until July 11, for the construction of approximately 77 miles of highway. This call covers one of the largest highway development projects undertaken in the Northwest this year. The new highways are to be located in Custer and Lemhi counties, Idaho.

CAMP LEWIS ICE PLANT WILL COST \$72,000.00
TACOMA, Wash.—The ice plant and ice storage building at Camp Lewis will be completed in July and will have a capacity of 20 tons of ice per day, and will have cost \$72,000.

FIRES

Fire at the Hanbury mill on False Creek yesterday afternoon did about \$1,000 damage in the boiler-room.

DAWSON.—Fire damage estimated at approximately \$75,000 was caused to the machine shops of the Canadian Klondike Mining Company at Bear Creek.

NEW WESTMINSTER.—Damage to the extent of several hundred dollars was caused when fire broke out in the rear part of the Model Grocery, located at 308 Sixth Street.

CLE ELUM, Wash.—Thirty blocks of this city were swept by fire Tuesday afternoon and more than 1,500 persons are homeless. The loss is estimated at \$1,500,000.

It was necessary to do it, or a considerable quantity of Washington's excellent apples would have gone to waste. Johnston and Anderson, Entiat, Wash., proceeded to keep these apples fit for the market. They worked in shifts—7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., 7 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.—with their two-ton Federal for ninety-five days. In this time they hauled 63,927 boxes of apples—1078

tons—hauls ranging from four to twelve miles, from the different ranches to a central packing shed, for .016 cents per box—60 cents per ton. H. J. Tucker, 833 Pender St. West, is local agent for the Federal truck.

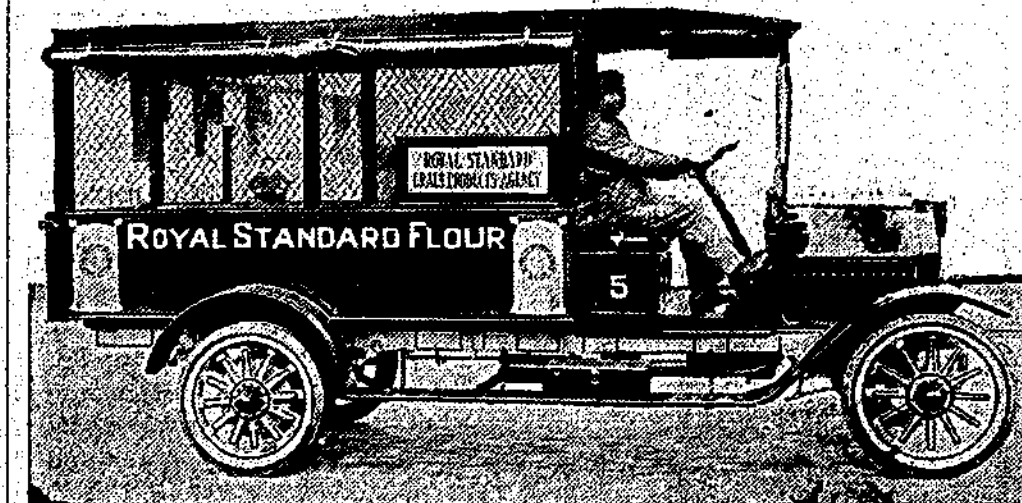

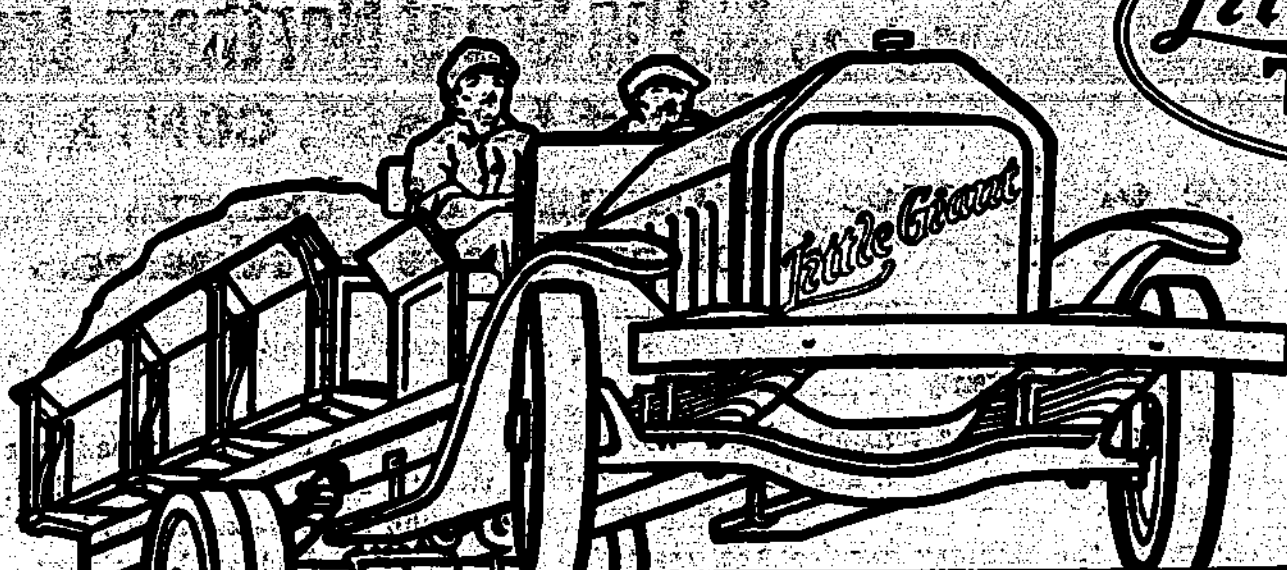
