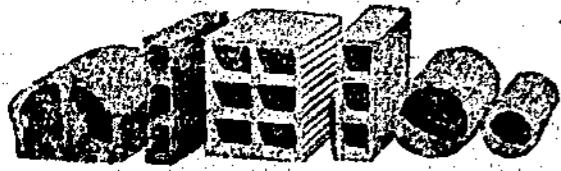

TO UNDERTAKE REPAIR OF ROOF OF WHARF SHED

The board of harbor commissioners has awarded the contract for the repairing of the roof of the No. 2 shed at the government wharf to the McLeod Sheet Metal Works, 1042 Richards street. The exact amount of the contract will depend on the area found necessary to repair, but it is already known that this will be quite extensive. The repairs are to be made with an asphalt and gravel six-ply roofing, and the shed roof is to be given a thorough renovation. Work is to be started on the job at once.

CONTRACT FOR BRICK POWER HOUSE AWARDED

Having about completed the excavation for the power house unit of the new factory on Drake street for the Dominion Cannery, Ltd., Mr. Frederick Sherborne, 77 Fifty-fifth avenue, west, South Vancouver, has also been awarded the contract for the erection of the brick power house, which is to cost about \$10,000. The award of the contract is announced by Architect J. E. Parr, Carter-Cotton building, who prepared the plans and is supervising the erection of the new factory. Mr. Sherborne was the successful tenderer for the excavation and foundation for the power house.

\$10,000 ADDITION

In connection with the remodelling the Chamberlain block at the corner of Seymour and Cordova streets for David Spencer, Limited, the Dominion Construction Co. have taken out a permit for an additional storey to that building to cost \$10,000.

WILL AWARD CONTRACT SOON FOR FINE HOME

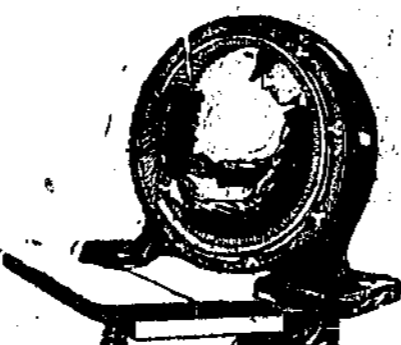
Plans have been prepared by Architect H. H. Gillingham, 1502 Tower

building, who expects to award the contract this week, for a fine residence to be erected for Mr. F. G. Evans at the corner of Twenty-ninth avenue and Margaret street, Point Grey. The dwelling will be of frame and stucco construction and will have five rooms on the ground floor and five upstairs. The plans provide for a handsome porte cochere, and a full concrete basement. A garage also of stucco construction to match the house, is also to form part of the contract. It has not yet been definitely decided whether a hot water or hot air heating system will be installed.

WOODWARD'S BUILDING PROGRAMME DEFERRED BUT WILL BE ENLARGED

With the acquisition by the Woodward Departmental Stores, Ltd., of another 50 feet frontage on Hastings street, comprised in the building at present occupied by the J. N. Harvey, clothing firm, the Woodward firm now control 185 feet frontage, or about half of the block between Abbott and Cambie streets. The price paid for the Harvey store and premises is stated to be \$140,000, which is conceded to be a pretty fair bargain for such desirable Hastings street realty.

As the lease of the present Harvey premises runs until next January, the previously arranged building programme of the Woodward firm has been considerably altered. It was originally intended to have commenced the erection of a six or eight story building uniform with the present department store at the corner of Abbott and Hastings street, some time this summer. The building programme called for an expenditure of about \$400,000 on the construction of this new building. But with the acquisition of the additional frontage comprised in the Harvey store, the necessity for a complete revision of the original plans, combined with the present high prices of building materials, combined with the uncertainty that exists in the labor market, the firm has decided to defer the start on its building programme until next spring. It was stated to The Record by a member of the Woodward firm that it is planned to start early in the spring of 1921 on the demolition of the building now occupying the Hastings street frontage from the department store to the westerly limit of the Harvey store. Meanwhile plans are to be prepared for a six or eight story building that will occupy that entire frontage and will probably close to \$1,000,000.

**BUILDING STILL BRISK ALL OVER
UNITED STATES**

According to a summary of build-
ing operations from all points in the
United States and a number of Can-
adian cities as secured by Bradstreets,
constructional activity continues to
show a healthy increase. Notwith-
standing reports of scarcity and record
high prices of all kinds of build-
ing materials of new and every in-
creasing demands for advances in
wages, and of high money rates caus-
ing cancellations aggregating the huge
sum of one billion dollars, the filing
of new plans for building goes on rap-
idly in most Canadian and American
cities. It is worth noting, however,
that the passage and operation of the
great bills in New York state has tend-
ed to operate as a check to real estate
operations in the metropolis. Whether
this will also affect building operations
remains to be seen but the housing
shortage continues so acute it is not
expected to affect conditions very long.

Reports secured from 149 cities in
the United States and 9 in Canada,
show 30,593 permits issued in March
providing for the construction of
\$139,104,195 worth of new buildings or
of alterations. These figures mark an
increase of 17.5 per cent. in permits
and of 135 per cent. in value as com-
pared with March of last year in the
same identical cities. This total of
value and the gain over March a year
ago are both very large, and it is in-
teresting to note that with only 149
cities out of 163 regularly reporting,
the March total is the largest recorded
since last December, and has only
been exceeded in three months since
August, October and December of last
year.

These comparisons with the best
months of last year are illustrative of
the building returns were first compil-
ed by Bradstreets. Those months were
the continuing strength of the build-
ing movement, though it should be
borne in mind that the gains over
previous years to 1919 need to be
considered with some regard to the
great advances that have occurred in
material and labor as compared with
earlier years. In other words, there
is probably as great a gain in area
or floor space of buildings erected as
the much advanced returns of value
would indicate.

The total number of permits issued
in 9 Canadian cities for March was
1,251, and their total value was \$4,668,
759, representing an increase of 112.1

value of the building in that period
as compared with March, 1919.

**HUDSON'S BAY COMPANY
TO BUILD AT WINNIPEG**

\$5,000,000, some time this year.

**ROAD CONTRACTS AT
MATSQUI ARE AWARDED**

MATSQUI—The Matsqui municipal
council has awarded several contracts
for road work in the municipality on
which work is to be commenced at
once. The contract for repairs to the
Mathers road was awarded to Matthew
Graham for \$1,007. R. H. Macgee was
the successful tenderer on the re-
pairs to the Huntingdon road and his
bid of \$467 was accepted. W. Murphy
was also awarded a contract for re-
pairs to the road near the station at
\$150. A grant of \$250 was also made
for grading work on the Glenmore
road, and an additional \$100 was voted
for work on that road from the town
line to the boundary of the ward. Re-
pairs to Marshall road at a cost of
\$150 were also authorized.

**PLANS PACKING PLANT
ON SITE NEAR EBURNE**

Backed by local capital, a new com-
pany has been organized and incor-
porated under the title of the Brit-
ish-Canadian Meat Packers Company,
Limited, with head office in Vancou-
ver, and capitalized at \$500,000. The
company has recently acquired and
will shortly take over the wholesale
meat and dairy produce business of
Charles Taylor & Company, formerly
of Calgary, and the plans for the im-
mediate future include the erection of
a modern meat packing plant and ab-
attoir on an excellently situated site
of four acres which has recently been
secured near Eburne.

Plans for the new abattoir and meat
packing plant which will be strictly
modern and sanitary in every particu-
lar, are to be prepared shortly. It is
estimated the first units of the plant
will cost about \$100,000. The board
of directors of the new company in-
clude: Mr. Charles Taylor of the Cal-
Van Products Company, managing di-
rector; H. H. Beck of the Union Trust
Company of Toronto, and E. A. All-
ison of Vancouver.

**B. C. MARINE TO BUILD
NEW VESSEL FOR H. B. CO.**

At a figure that is said to approxi-
mate \$300,000, the B. C. Marine, Ltd.,
has been awarded the contract for
the construction of the new auxiliary
schooner intended as an Arctic trad-
ing vessel, for the Hudson's Bay Com-
pany. The award of the contract was
made by Capt. J. Fitzgerald, marine
superintendent of the Hudson's Bay
Company, after a careful inspection
and investigation of the equipment
and facilities of various local yards,
with a view to ascertaining what firm
was best situated to turn out the ves-
sel as quickly as possible.

The new schooner which is to be
very staunchly built and will have a
special sheathing of selected oak as
well as steel armor on the bow to en-
able her to withstand ice pressure and
cut her way through floating ice, is to
be 200 feet in length with a beam of
36 feet and a depth of 12 feet. She
will carry about 1,200 tons as well as
oil fuel for a large cruising radius.
Speed in construction is desired as it
is planned to have the vessel launch-
ed in August and taken north around
through Behring Sea to the mouth of
the Mackenzie River, on which stream
she is to be used for trading pur-
poses. Manager James Innes Hopkins
of the B. C. Marine announces that an
early start is to be made on the con-

struction of the vessel which will be
the first of this particular type for
Arctic work that has ever been con-
structed in local shipyards.

**PREPARING PLANS FOR
STORAGE WAREHOUSE**

intended to provide for the care of
large fruit shipments, will be a three
story structure 85 by 150 feet in size
and of tile construction. It is ex-
pected that plans will be completed ready
for work to be started in about two
weeks time. The work will probably
be done by Okanagan contractors.

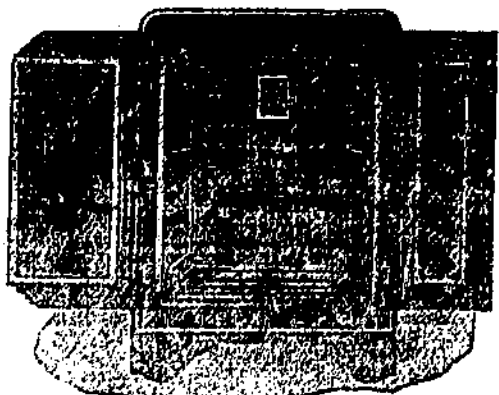
