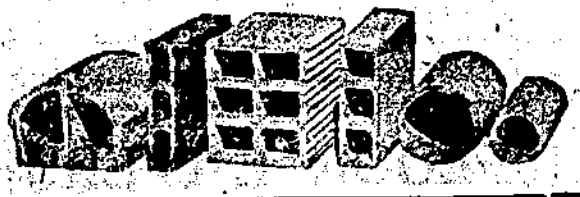

**PROMINENT ARCHITECTS JOIN FORCES IN NEW FIRM**  
Fred L. Townley and Robt. M. Matheson Form Partnership  
—Both Have Designed Many Notable Buildings Here.

Two very well-known young local architects, after having been playmates and pals from childhood, but each hitherto having "paddled his own canoe" have decided to join forces for the future. The new firm of Townley & Matheson, associate architects, comprising Mr. Fred L. Townley and Mr. Robt. M. Matheson, is quite the most notable business organization that has taken place in local professional circles for some time. They have opened offices at 325 Homer Street.

This is an oft-quoted adage that "there is no sentiment in business; but there must have been something closely approaching it in the new partnership which has been formed by these two popular young architects—each of whom may be said to have earned a well deserved reputation for himself single-handed. Both have lived in Vancouver for over 30 years, except during the time they were at college, and in Mr. Townley's case, he is a native son and also son of a former mayor. Both were graduates in 1911 of the Department of Architecture, University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, and received further training in the offices of some of the leading architects in the large cities of the United States. Upon their return here to embark in business they each attained a gratifying measure of success. Their host of friends in the professional, building and allied trades in Vancouver and vicinity are unanimous in predicting a bright future for these two young men in partnership.  
Mr. Townley achieved prominence some years ago, when in competition with prominent architects all over Can-

add his designs and plans for the new local terminals, depot and freight sheds for the Great Northern and Northern Pacific Railroads were adopted. He was also a prize winner in the Vancouver Civic Centre competition, and more recently "his design for the city's war memorial to be erected on Memorial Square, was practically accepted. One of his most recent undertakings was the Terminal City Motor Company's Garage building and service station on Georgia and Dute streets.  
Mr. Matheson, the older son of the late J. P. Matheson, one of Vancouver's pioneer contractors, who before taking up the study of architecture spent many years with his father in actual construction work, is thus able to bring the knowledge of this valuable experience into the partnership. In fact few architects of Mr. Matheson's age can look back on so much practical experience in all lines of construction work, a factor which is bound to be a valuable asset to the new firm.  
Mr. Matheson, also has a number of notable edifices standing in the city as monuments to his ability as a designer, structures that are considered models of their kind. Among the more recent of these is the First Church of Christ, Scientist. He also designed Caroline Court and McNeill, Welch & Wilson warehouses.  
Both Mr. Townley and Mr. Matheson have also specialized in fine homes in the Shaughnessy Heights section and along Marine Drive in Point Grey. Among some of the handsome residences they have designed in these districts may be mentioned those owned by Mr. F. R. McEl, Russell, Mr. E. C. Knight, Mr. J. H. Craig, Dr. Archibald Smith, Mr. Wm. G. Breeze, Mr. Willard Kitchen, Mr. S. S. Selman, Mr. J. D. McNeill and Mr. William Metz.

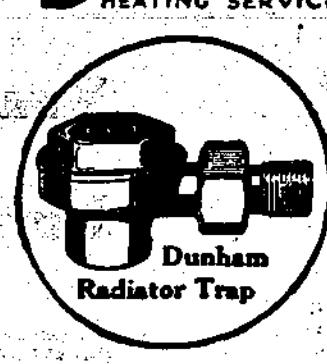

**FOREIGN TRADE NOTES**  
The Japanese government has announced the appointment of the extraordinary financial and economic investigation commission, which will assume functions of much wider scope than those of the former commission, which has been dissolved. The new commission will be directed by Premier Hara as chairman, and it will investigate and consider the more important financial and economic questions which will be referred to it by the various governmental departments. Special care should be taken in packing automobiles which are to be shipped to Dutch East Indian ports, as several cases have been reported where parts of cars were stolen. There seems to be a practice among many consignees to leave their freight in the dock warehouses until they are ready to take delivery. There are approximately 12,000 motor cars in use throughout the Dutch East Indies, and practically all cars imported since 1915 have been of American manufacture. Previous to that year French and Italian cars were predominant and recent exports indicate that manufacturers in these two countries are making strenuous efforts to regain this market.

A glass manufacturing plant is to be erected near Himeji, Japan, by the Kyokuto Glass Co., a \$3,000,000 corporation of Osaka. The new factory will manufacture chiefly "wire glass" on a royalty arrangement with an American firm. Practically all the electrical fixtures and supplies imported into New Zealand during the past four years have come from the United States. At the present time there is said to be a shortage in the New Zealand market for electrical materials for the equipment of homes which are being constructed for returned soldiers. On July 31 last the government of British India abolished the passage control on outgoing steamers. It is therefore no longer necessary, when desiring to leave the country, to file a petition setting forth the urgency of departure. The very high cost of coal in Japan should create a good demand for gas-producing engines in that country. These engines are at present very little known there but it is probable a good market could be developed.
