### FEDERAL WATERS THIRSTY

#### STOCK IN NEW MEXICO

Makes Haul of 15 Miles Daily Over a Prairie Without Roads and Over Grades of from 10 to 12%.

Nearly every part of the country has been well watered with rains this season. Not only have the "lows"—the large storm areas—been well distributed, but the country at large has been visited by numerous thunder storms, making crops grow fast and helping to produce one of the largest crops of grain, and produce that the country has ever known. The Government reports state that corn, wheat, oats, potatoes in aggregate will be the largest crops ever grown.

There are very few parts of the country which have been dry. A considerable portion of New Mexico lies within this arid territory.

Worswick & Jones, of Roswell, N. M., have large ranch interests and raise sheep and cattle in great numbers.

Their Federal is used for hauling general ranch supplies, such as well casings, windmills, building material, and water for the sheep and cattle where they are grazing out of reach

of water. The water is hauled from the water well, which is, in the terms of the old plainsman, a "water hole." The truck is equipped with a tank holding 350 gallons, and the side of the body contains holders for well casing.

### KNOW YOUR CAR.

Along these same lines is the question that every motor car driver should ask himself before starting out on a trip. Is my car in good shape and is my equipment complete and in working order. Every owner should be thoroughly informed as to the operation of his car, thus eliminating unnecessary service. If all owners would see that their cars are properly equipped, that their tools are in order, that extra tubes and tires and repair kits are in proper repair, they will conserve time, labor and material for the government, and eliminate the emergency work due to lack of proper equipment. Owners should consider it a patriotic duty to make minor repairs to tires and motor while on the road. The following suggestions are made with the idea of conservation in mind.

Make certain that your car is plentifully supplied with gasoline, oil and water before starting on a trip. Look over your tires, see that they are properly inflated and that valve and dust caps are on tight. Keep your car clean. Don't allow mud to dry on brakes and steering gear.

Familiarize yourself with the rules of the road.

Put distilled water in your battery at least every ten days.

Keep battery plates covered with water. Do not fill battery to top.

At all times be sure that gear shift is in neutral before starting your engine.

Be positive that your brakes are in perfect working order.

Have your lenses comply with the state law.

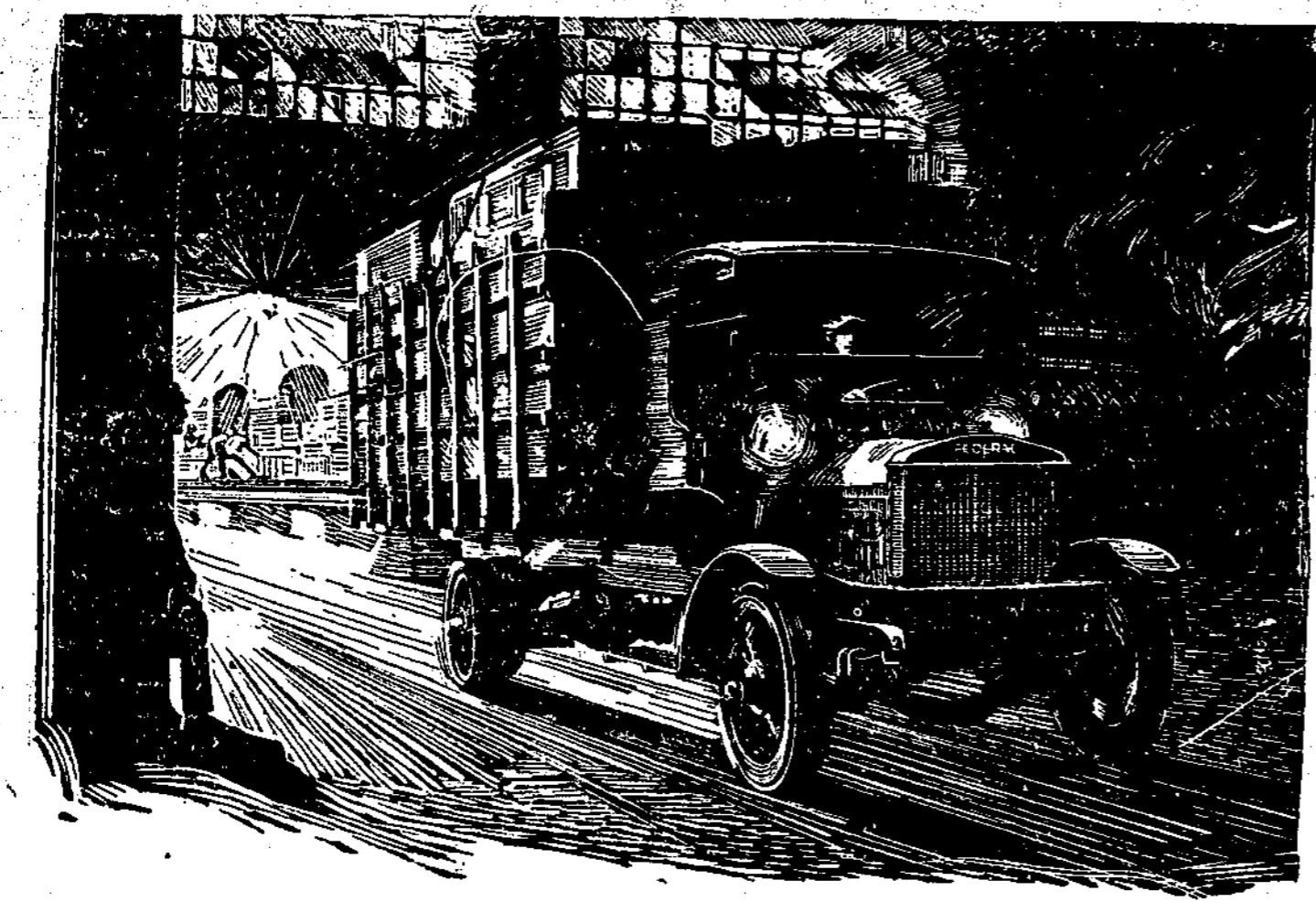
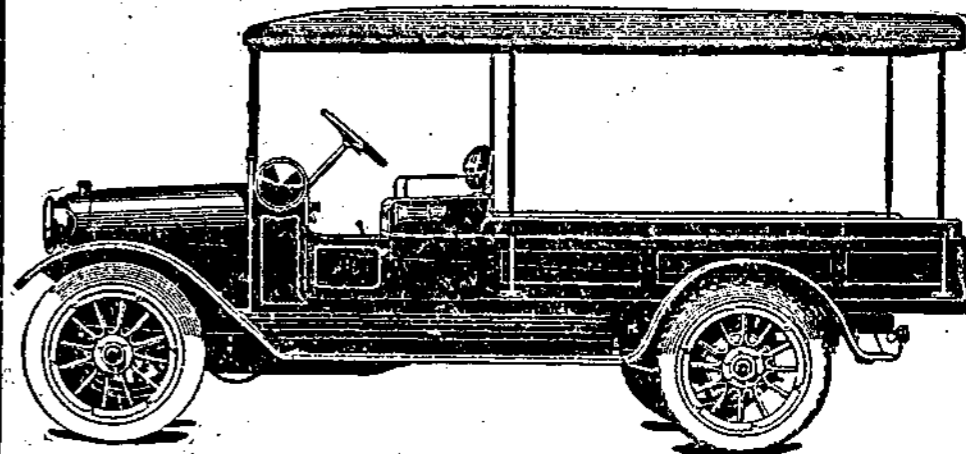
