CONTRACT TO BE AWARDED FOR LARGE WAREHOUSE

Tenders for the McClean Bros' big warehouse on Water st have been closed and the archt. Thomas Hooper, Winch bldg. will award the contract in a few days. The contractors will do all the sub-work. The bldg will be 5 full stories, with basement. Part of first floor will be used as office space and the front room of the first three stories will also be office room. The bldg will be reinforced concrete with mill construction for the interior. It will have exterior columns and curtain walls. The entire cost of construction will be \$60,000.

NEW WESTMINSTER TO HAVE NEW BUSINESS BLOCKS




